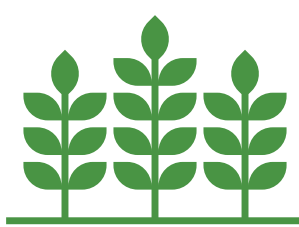

Who we are

The Geodata for Agriculture and Water Facility is a grant programme by the Netherlands Ministry of Foreign Affairs within the policy priorities for food security and water, which is executed by the Netherlands Space Office (NSO). It promotes and supports satellite based services which positively impact the lives of smallholder food producers.



What we do

The Geodata for Agriculture and Water Programme has provided 25 public private partnerships in 15 countries support to develop demand driven and satellite based information services for smallholder food producers in developing countries. The programme is executed by nearly 130 organisations, providing the following services.



Improve the output of the agricultural, pastoral and fishing sector by providing **agricultural advice to smallholder food producers** (e.g. crop management advice, pests and disease advice, fertilizer- and irrigation advice, routing advice).



Affordable satellite based insurance, is protecting smallholder farmers from the impact of climate change and enhances their resilience.



Enhancement of sustainable economic growth and self-reliance by providing **agri-financial services** in rural areas to smallholder farmers.



Access to accurate, localised weather information allowing farmers to make well-informed decisions and effectively manage and mitigate risk.



Market information services provide farmers with prices for livestock and staple grains enabling them to obtain a fair price for their products.

The G4AW approach aims to reach 4.5 million food producers by 2022. In order to reach that goal we call upon investors, governments, development banks, insurance companies, foundations, NGO's and venture funds to address the needs and constraints of these food producers, providing access to G4AW like services.
