


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
For victory claiming!







THEORY OF CHANGE



AN EXAMPLE

Farmers

• Knowledge
• Budget

• e.g. GAP training farmers => training report

• 1.000 farmers have received GAP training

Victory Claim: Based on contribution (e.g. was training needed?) and attribution (e.g. better seeds from government?) Impact: **Outcome: Increased** Indicators: 500 farmers food security apply GAP, increased yield per hectare Side effects: increased environmental impact of pesticides?



LOGICAL FRAMEWORK IN MONITORING FORMAT

Assumptions	Activity	Planned output	Realized output (incl. MoV)	Planned outcome	Realized outcome (incl. MoV)
Increased knowledge is necessary to improve yields	Training of 1.000 farmers	1.000 farmers must receive training	950 farmers have received training (950 signed presence lists)	Yields per ha must increase 25%	Yields per ha have increased 20% (field measurements)



EXERCISE

Discuss in groups strategies for dealing with M&E







- Make sure you fully understand NSO's M&E requirements!
- Summarize all requirements and promises made and, if necessary, redefine the logical framework. Put this in a monitoring format and get this approved by NSO.





- Identify possible 'attribution' and 'side effect' issues. Determine monitoring indicators and include these in a possible baseline study.
- Conduct periodic monitoring and apply adaptive management. Communicate changes with NSO!





- For final project evaluation: consider the following issues before 'victory claiming'!
 - Contribution: logic link between activities and outcomes? Were assumptions correct?
 - Attribution: other activities / developments have influenced outcome?
 - Side effects: (un)intended direct or indirect effects of the project?
